PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy explains how personal data is collected, used, stored, protected and transferred when persons use this website or otherwise interact with EBSCA, EBCA or WBSC Europe in relation to EBSCA activities.

This policy is intended to comply with applicable data protection rules, including the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), applicable French data protection law, the Swiss Federal Act on Data Protection (FADP) and, where applicable, relevant privacy requirements for persons located in the United States.

Where WBSC Europe is the responsible organization for specific processing, Swiss law and the WBSC Europe Data Protection Policy principles apply, taking GDPR principles into account.

PURPOSES OF PROCESSING

Personal data collected through this website is used for the organization, administration and communication of EBSCA, EBCA and WBSC Europe activities. These purposes include membership administration; event, convention, clinic, camp and program registration; participant accreditation and attendance management; certificate generation and verification; payment, invoicing, donation and accounting administration; member area access; communication with members, participants, donors, partners and applicants; contact form and partner request follow-up; coach development activities; public sports, education and development reporting; internal statistics, historical records and organizational reporting; security, fraud prevention, spam prevention and technical website operation.

Personal data may also be used for compatible further processing where the later use remains reasonably connected to the original purpose. This includes using membership, event, attendance, certification or communication data for related EBSCA, EBCA or WBSC Europe organizational, historical, coach-development, certification or communication purposes.

TYPES OF DATA

Depending on the activity, EBSCA, EBCA or WBSC Europe may process name and contact details; email address and phone number; address and country; organization, club, federation or company; membership type and membership history; event registrations and attendance; payment, invoice and donation references; dietary or accessibility information where needed for an event; travel or accommodation information where needed for an event; sport discipline and coaching-related information; photos, video or media content where relevant to public events, news or event

reporting; communication history; technical data such as IP address, browser information, user agent and security logs.

Sensitive data is only collected where necessary and appropriate for the relevant activity, or where the data subject has provided explicit information for a specific purpose.

LEGAL BASIS

The legal basis for processing may include performance of a contract or pre-contractual measures; compliance with legal, tax, accounting or administrative obligations; legitimate interest in managing memberships, events, coach development, communications, certification, security and organizational history; consent, where explicitly requested; compatible further processing for related EBSCA, EBCA and WBSC Europe purposes; establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims; compliance with applicable sport rules, federation requirements or public authority requests.

Consent may be requested through digital forms, digital checkboxes, written forms or other clear affirmative actions.

For persons under the age of eighteen, or persons who cannot legally provide informed consent, consent must be provided by a parent, legal guardian or duly authorized representative where required.

DATA DELETION AND CONSEQUENCES

Data subjects may request deletion of their personal data where legally possible.

However, users should understand that deletion of information required for membership, event registration, payment administration, attendance verification, certification or member area access may automatically make it impossible to maintain or provide those services.

This means that a person who requests deletion of required personal data may no longer be able to hold or renew an EBSCA membership; register for events; participate in events that require identification, payment, membership validation or attendance records; access the member area; receive or verify certificates; receive invoices, confirmations or event communications; maintain historical participation or membership records.

Some data may still be retained where required for legal, tax, accounting, payment, security, certification, dispute-resolution or legitimate organizational purposes.

DATA SHARING

Personal data is not sold. Personal data is not shared with third parties for third-party advertising.

Personal data may be shared where necessary with EBCA; WBSC Europe; authorized EBSCA staff, board members or administrators; event organizers and operational event partners; local federations or sports organizations where relevant to a specific activity; partner organizations, including non-European organizations, where relevant to a program, membership benefit, exchange program or event; payment providers; invoicing, accounting and administrative service providers; website hosting, email, security, database and IT providers; public authorities where legally required; insurance, legal or professional advisers where necessary.

Third parties may only process personal data as required for the relevant service or activity. Where a local federation, partner organization or external organization is independently responsible for its own activities, its own legal and privacy rules may also apply.

PUBLIC EVENTS, PHOTO AND VIDEO

At public events such as conventions, camps, clinics, ceremonies, games, meetings or side events, EBSCA, EBCA or WBSC Europe may take photos, record video or publish event-related media.

Where possible, participants and visitors will be informed through event notices, registration information or venue notices.

Photos, video, names, roles, countries, clubs, organizations, results, awards, attendance or similar event-related information may be published for sports, communication, reporting, historical or promotional purposes, provided this remains proportionate and lawful.

PAYMENTS

Online payments are processed by external payment providers such as Stripe or other payment processors.

Full payment card details are not stored on EBSCA servers.

EBSCA may store payment references, transaction status, invoice references, donation records and accounting information required for administration, support, reconciliation, tax and legal compliance.

INTERNATIONAL DATA TRANSFERS

Personal data may be processed or accessed in countries including France, Switzerland, other European countries and, where relevant, the United States or other countries connected to hosting, email, payment, federation, event, program or technical service providers.

Where required, international transfers are handled through appropriate safeguards, such as adequacy decisions, contractual protections or comparable lawful mechanisms.

DATA SECURITY

EBSCA, EBCA and WBSCEurope take reasonable technical and organizational measures to protect personal data against unauthorized access, loss, misuse, disclosure or alteration.

Access to personal data is limited to persons who need access for their role or service.

In the event of a data breach that is likely to significantly affect the rights or interests of persons concerned, EBSCA, EBCA or WBSCEurope will take appropriate steps in accordance with applicable law.

RETENTION

Personal data is retained only as long as necessary for the purposes for which it was collected, or as required for legal, accounting, tax, certification, historical, security, federation or legitimate organizational purposes.

Membership, event, attendance and certificate records may be retained for longer periods where needed to preserve organizational history, verify participation, issue or verify certificates, manage member records or protect legal interests.

When personal data is no longer needed, it may be deleted, anonymized or permanently pseudonymized.

DATA SUBJECT RIGHTS

Depending on applicable law, data subjects may have the right to request access to their personal data; request correction of inaccurate or incomplete data; request deletion where legally possible; request restriction of processing; object to processing; request data portability where applicable; withdraw consent where processing is based on consent; lodge a complaint with a competent data protection authority.

Withdrawal of consent does not affect processing that took place before withdrawal. It also does not prevent processing that remains necessary for contractual, legal, accounting, certification, security, legitimate organizational or legal-claim purposes.

Where applicable, complaints may be submitted to the competent data protection authority, including the CNIL in France, the Federal Data Protection and Information Commissioner in Switzerland, or another competent local authority.
